Optimistic and Supercheck For getting hitched and still having the energy on Sunday morning to hash!

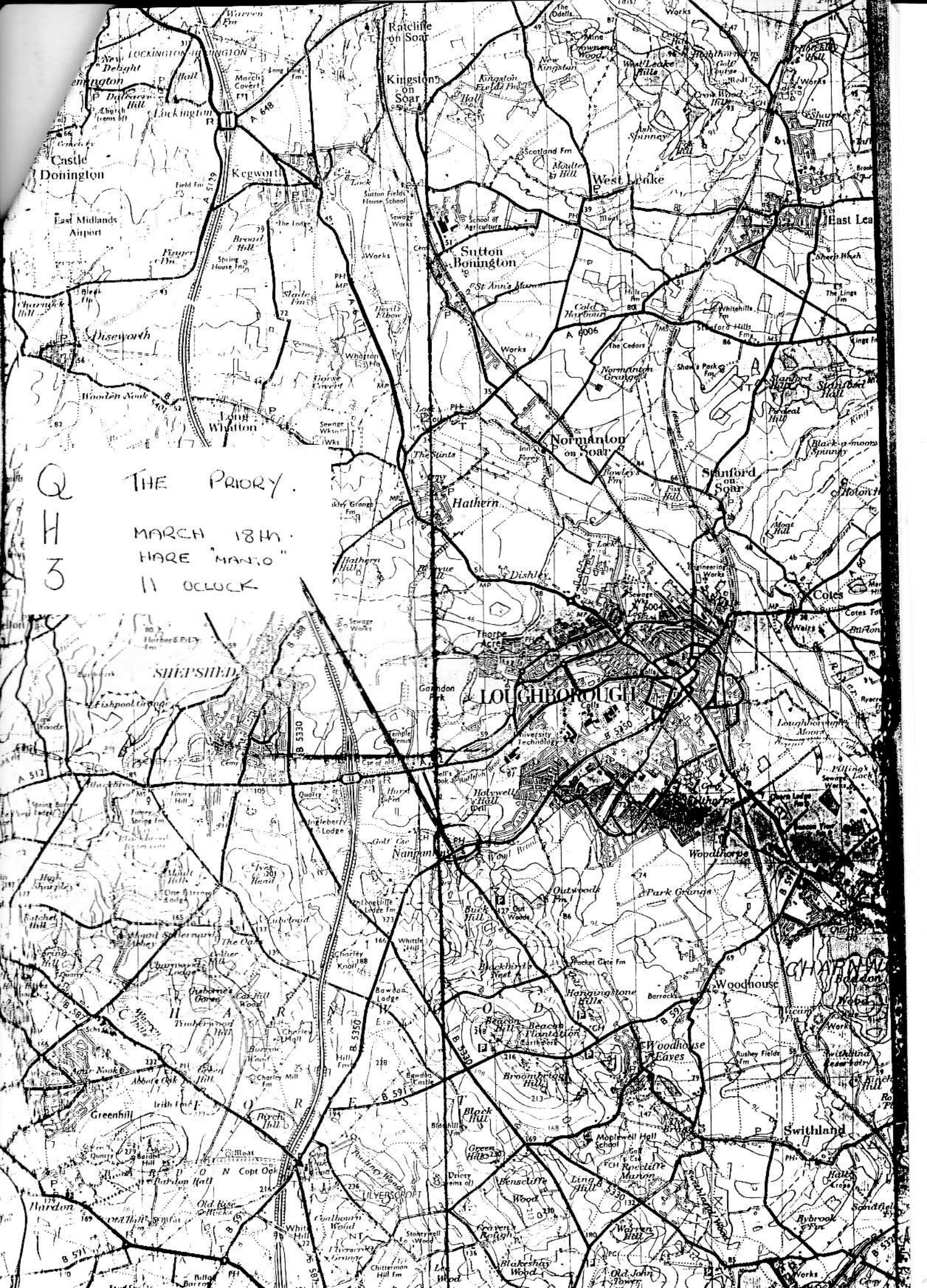
