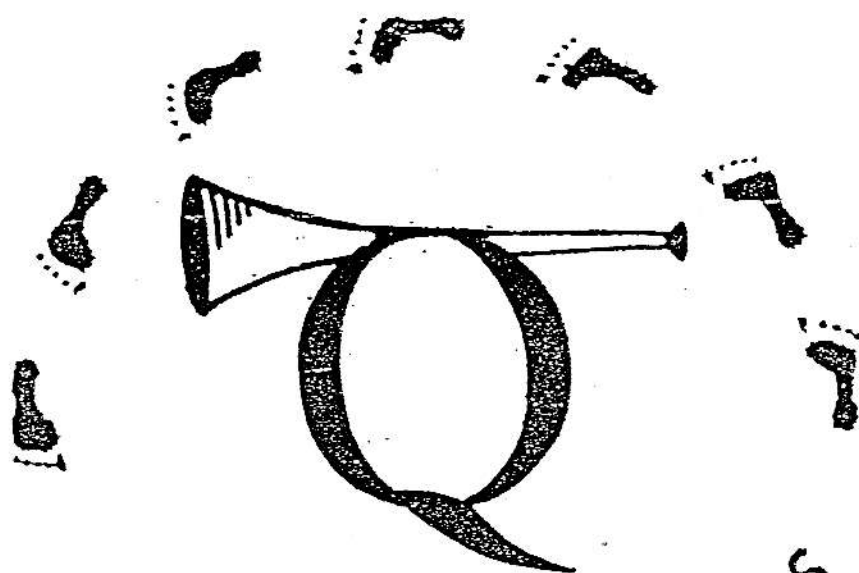

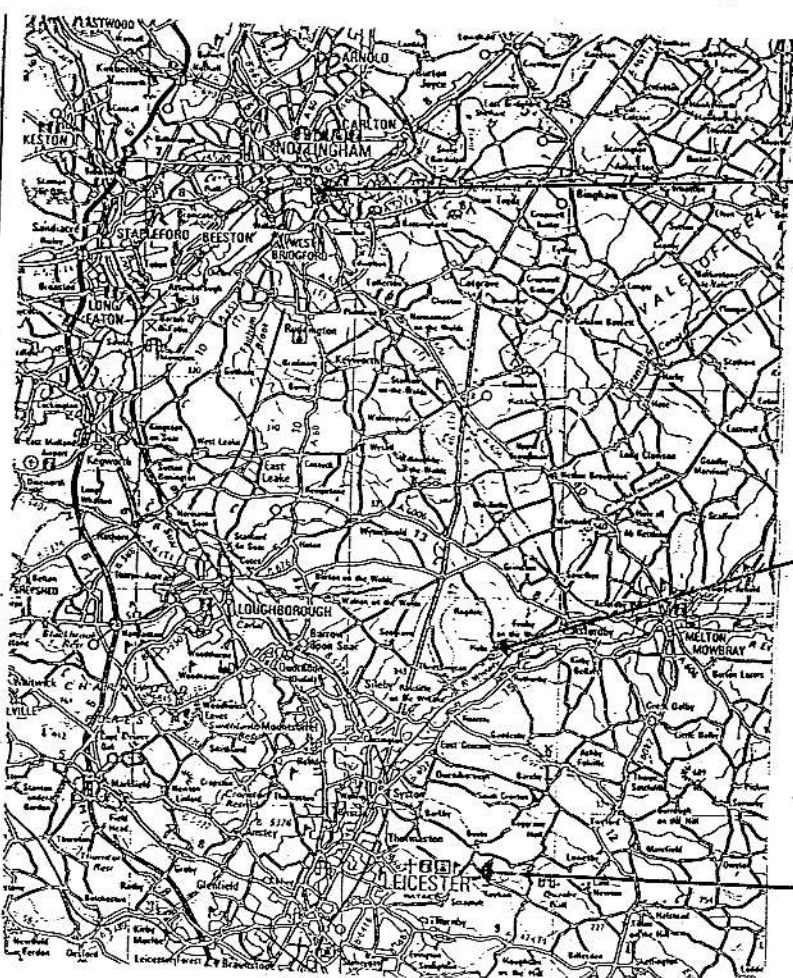

I found it easy to sample this curious mixture: just a phone call located the nearest group (pack? Herd?). The voice on the phone was cheerful and welcoming, and told me that the venue was a local country pub.

BOOZY BUNNIES CATCH CHARTERS ON THE HOP

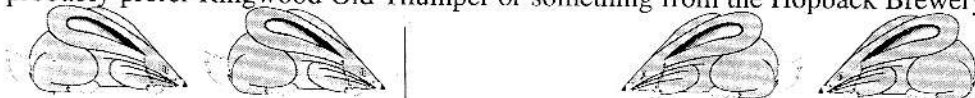
