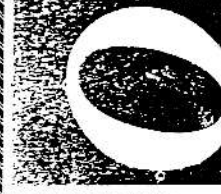

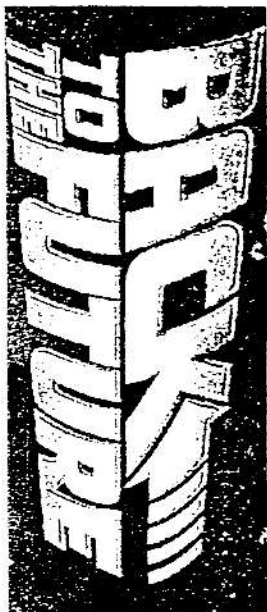

## NASH HASH 99 UPDATE

With many hashers already giving considerable thought to their Nash Hash trip, we thought it might be appropriate, in view of the high numbers of hashers attending their first Nash Hash (and an equally high number of seasoned hashers who haven't ventured to Scotland before) to give you an idea of what you are letting yourself in for and also answer a few of the questions being asked (with the proviso that things may change as circumstances dictate.).

The image of Scotland as being a land of shimmering lochs, craggy mountain tops, spectacular waterfalls and deep cut, forest filled glens may be generally a bit overstated – but, we're pleased to say, in the Trossachs that's exactly what you get.

The area lies about twenty four miles north of Glasgow and is within taxi range of both Glasgow Airport and both main Glasgow railway stations. We are supplying an information sheet (not exhaustive) containing both taxi numbers (includes mini buses) and indicative costs plus accommodation available in the local area. The Nash Hash weekend is not a main holiday weekend in Scotland but will still be quite busy. With all the beds at the Nash Hash venue now gone those of you who don't fancy camping and wish to stay offsite should book as soon as possible.

Those of you coming up for longer stays should contact the Scottish Tourist Board who will be happy to be of assistance. The World Pipe Band Championships and the Edinburgh Festival all take place around this time and you may be able to take part in the Glasgow City of Architecture and Design 1999 festivities.

*You've made it to Nash Hash –now what?*

Nash Hash will commence p.m. on Friday 27 August and finish c.lunchtime, Monday 30 August. For the most part we expect hashers to arrive after noon on 27<sup>th</sup> and be offsite by mid-afternoon on Monday 30<sup>th</sup>. The chalets will require to be vacated in advance of this time. The event will essentially be all-inclusive from the opening ceremony onwards with the exception of Friday night snacks and Monday lunch.

Runs will take place generally within the local area, may involve a short bus journey and will satisfy all standards of runner.

Entertainment has been organised for each night in the form of bands supplemented by a disco. There will be the usual Hash Cabaret on Sunday – if you're doing one let us know (the stage will be 10 m x6 m approx. but remember it may have band equipment on it). The 'tent', a former circus big top should, because of its width, afford everyone a view of the stage. On Saturday afternoon, after the runs, the Lomond Folk Club will be on hand to entertain. Hashland Games under the control of 'none other than John Anderson' will fill the equivalent spot on Sunday afternoon

The theme for the weekend is 'Auld Lang Syne' as Nash Hash 99 bids goodbye to the current millenium. The Saturday night fancy dress theme is 'Millenium Moments' (MM).

If you feel like washing over the course of the weekend, each chalet has 3 showers (60 in total) with further showers being provided for those unable to persuade a chalet dweller to share theirs.

# InterHash 2002

## Background

In October we wrote to all the UK Hashes to let you know that a number of us were working to prepare a bid to be submitted at the next world InterHash (being held in Tasmania next February) to hold the following world InterHash in 2002 in the UK.

In order to host the event in the UK we need to find a locality where we have the support of the local Council; where there is a venue big enough for 3,000 – 4,000 ish (or more) Hashers, with nearby parking for 60 Buses; and with enough accommodation, ranging from Camping (primarily for the UK Hashers) up to 5 star (for the wealthy yanks); that is able to cope with (at the worst case) all 3,000 - 4,000 Hashers arriving on a Thursday and leaving on a Monday - all in a small geographic area – and preferably with a local Hash or two with the interest to be involved in (though not necessarily lead, or Manage) the event.

## Initial Progress

On the basis of the initial support and interest that we received from various UK Hashes and individual Hashers we have undertaken discussions with the local & regional Councils in Scarborough, Chester & North Wales, Cardiff, Cheltenham, and Plymouth.

These discussions have confirmed even more the necessity of support & backing from the local Council, and as a result of the support we have now narrowed down our review of available facilities to Cardiff, Plymouth and Chester.

We have already been to see the facilities available in Cardiff, which confirmed that there was a suitable venue, that there was sufficient accommodation, that the transport links were more than adequate, and that the running (who said Running?) country was superb (everything from Coal Mines to Sand Dunes) - and that we had the full support of Cardiff Council.

We will shortly be visiting Plymouth & Chester and will then be in a position to confirm the venue around which we will be building the bid. Our aim is to be able to announce the venue within the next two months.

We have also commenced discussions with Brewers in order to get the best Beer at the best price (although from my experience no InterHash venue has yet been determined on the basis of the Hash brew) and have already received confirmation from Virgin Atlantic (ignore the Atlantic bit 'cos they already fly to Oz, Japan, Hong Kong, Malaysia & South Africa) that they wish to be the Event Airline.

Finally we have also visited - and hashed in - Colva (in Goa, in India), the only other known venue for the 2002 bid, to see whether it was so good as to make it worth delaying our bid until 2004. Our continuation of our bid for 2002 is as a result of our conviction that we can offer a better event.

Whilst our major efforts are going into finalising the venue, members of the organising committee have already arranged to attend some of the overseas events to start publicising the UK bid, so if you happen to be attending this year's InterGulf (in Oman in March), the Aussie NashHash (in Gold Coast in April) or Cairo's 1000<sup>th</sup> (guess where! – in May) then you will start to see the Publicity bandwagon in action.

### So what can you do to help the bid?

We are now at the stage where we need to start publicising the bid Nationally and Internationally. Whilst we have already raised money to cover the initial expenses (yes, we have put our money where our mouths are – or something like that!) we do need more substantial funding to publicise the bid adequately before Hashdom in general arrives in Tasmania next February.

First of all, if you support the concept of bringing the world InterHash to the UK, then please seek the support and agreement of your Hash Mismanagement Committee to make a donation towards the pre-bid publicity costs.

Secondly, consider the attached Letter offering **FREE Registration** to InterHash UK 2002 to Hashers who are prepared to part with £ 100 to purchase one of 100 **Debentures**, with an offer of the return of the money in full in the event that we win the bid (and OF COURSE a free T-shirt).
