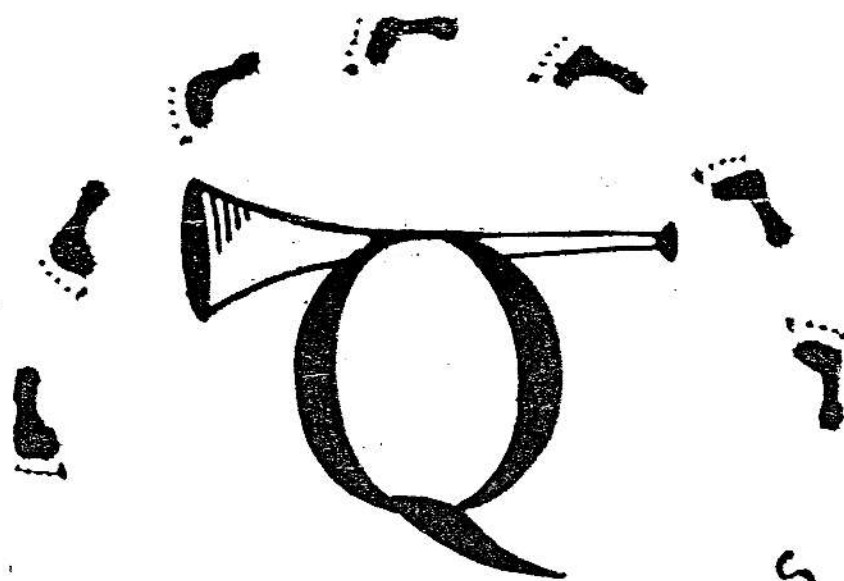
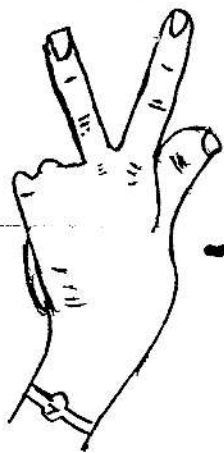

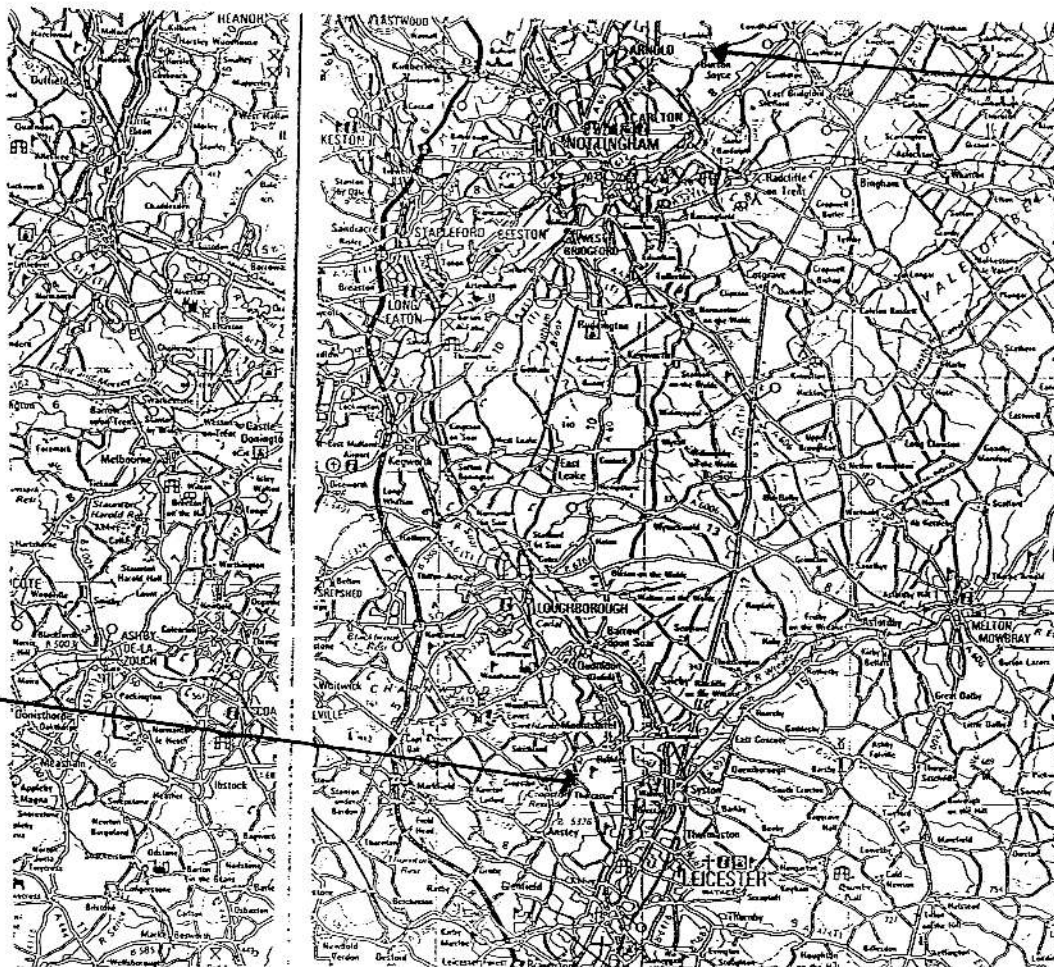

EARLY RETIREMENT

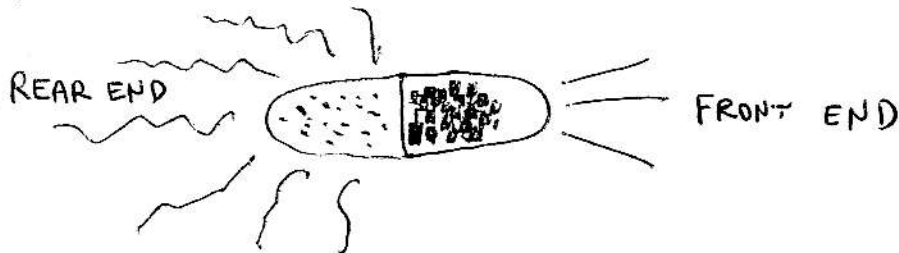

4th Commonwealth Hash '94

Vancouver and Victoria HHHs confirm being well down the track with preparations to jointly host the 4th Commonwealth Hash '94 over the first weekend of September (3-5). The event is traditionally held to mark the Commonwealth Games since Brisbane 1982; Edinburgh 1986 and Auckland 1990. At one stage before finally settling in Canada this year for August 18-28, India appeared also to be in the running as a potential Games host venue. Delhi HHH did not share their government's obvious disappointment when officials of the CG organising committee announced the bad news their nation was dropped from contention. Instead, mis-management apparently uttered sighs of relief, partying well into the night.

By contrast, however, Malaysian chapters are aggressively preparing to stage the event in 1998 and elevate it. Klang Valley's combined hashes are gearing towards hosting Interhash in what will be the 60th anniversary of hashing's formation there. Linking another event to Interhash not always proves successful. Four years ago for example, Auckland's big triple plans to celebrate Run 1000 on the Monday after Commonwealth Games Hash, followed by Interhash the next weekend, failed. Instead, Interhash '90 became a Thrilla in Manila. This time Cairns in Queensland will also be readying.

Canada's west coast hosts confirm that in addition to the three runs - titled Sea to Sky, Ben Johnson Memorial Steroids Sprint and the Dark Side of the Moon - a great Real McKenzie dance and farewell party are planned in Vancouver on the weekend. Hashers who will be in Victoria for the Games the previous weekend, can join in the Victoria H3's 100th anniversary run on August 27. All male hashers will be most welcome to join in the Hugh Jorgen run on the evening of September 1st in Vancouver.

Many will remember Vancouver hosted the friendly pre-ramble to Americas Interhash (Calgary '93) activities.

Spokesman Delhi Belly (formerly of the Little Sai Wan H3 in Hong Kong, and before that known as the "Viceroy" on the Delhi H3) reports: "Hashing is making great advances and strides here. In addition to the Vancouver H3 which is now over six years old, and with always a good turnout of 50 plus, there is a twice-monthly Lotus Land H3 and a Howlers Hash held at full moons. A newly-formed Hugh Jorgen Memorial H3 recently established for men-only. Their religious advisor, Peter 'Busted Colostomy Bag' Holeczek, trained in Pattaya, is expected to be highly visible at the proceedings.

Mashers living in the membership of British Commonwealth nations are encouraged to visit Canada in September for what will prove to be an excellent experience. As always, the Hash Hotline (604) 290-9443 awaits the casual visitor.

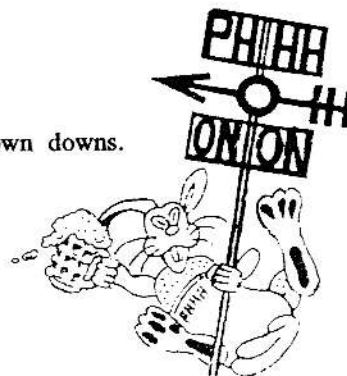
