




Dear Interhasher!

A very Merry Hashmas to the lot of you! Life has been busy here, but things go on apace without too many disasters so far. At the time of writing (end of October) the number of registrations is starting to pick up as the end of the first cut-off point approaches.

So far we have had registrations from over 100 different hashes, from 36 countries and over 20 different nationalities, from American to Zimbabwean. Hashnames have ranged from Ah! Pisto (Creek, Dubai) to Zoomie (Mijas, Spain).

A couple of items of concern have reached us. The first is about run length. We are advertising 45 min, 1 hr. 15 min, and 2 hr. runs. This means 45 minutes for a moderately fit hasher without taking any falsies or stopping at checks. At least one of the two hour runs will be a bit of a ball-breaker, but this will be made clear in your infopacks when you check in. We are not out to set marathon runs though.

The other item of debate which has reached us is the method of voting at the next GMs meeting. Should it be first past the post, secret ballot, Olympic style or what? You let us know your feelings, and we will make a decision based on the feedback we get from you. We will let everyone know how it will be run in our last flier in about a years time, so get writing.

As a means of helping Interhash's image, both here and abroad, there will be a definite amount of charity fundraising associated with the event. This does NOT mean that we are pushing up the reg. price so as to make money for charity. Your reg. fee goes on giving you a good time. Through the local English speaking LIONS, who are helping us in a number of areas, we intend to drag some cash from your pockets for a number of worthy causes, both here and internationally. If there are any hashers out there who are also LIONS, they should keep their ears to the ground for more information. As a rough guide, there is expected to be a sponsored marathon either before or after the event - probably on a Wednesday. If you have sponsorship up to a certain amount, you enter the marathon free, otherwise there will be a reg. fee. There will also be a raffle/draw at the event for a number of major prizes - Air Tickets, etc. the proceeds of which will go to charity.

Which charities will benefit will be made clear in next summers flier.

Accommodation/holiday package/flight request forms all come out in next summers flier. You should all receive this in August. The Flight Request form you send back or fax to Cyprus Airways Interhash Flight Desk here in Limassol, and the Hotel/Package form you return to the Interhash Travel Office, specially set up for us in London. All details in the next flier.

We have had a few requests for general information about Cyprus. Our postage bill for the event is going to be enormous anyway, so we are naturally reluctant to spend money sending brochures overseas. This Costs! Included with this flier are the addresses of the Cyprus Tourism Organisation bureaux overseas. Write to your nearest one and we are sure they will help you all they can.






