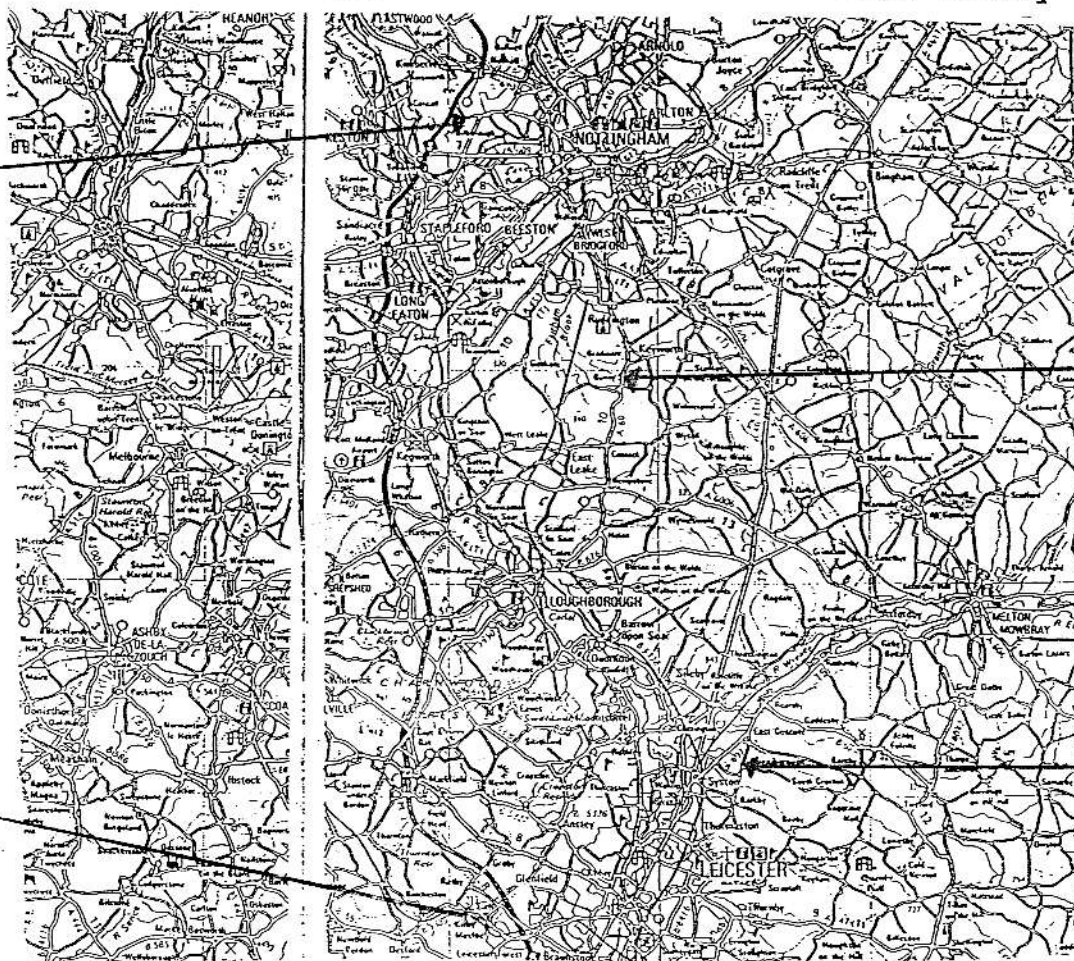

Happy new year to you all. The countdown to the 200th has begun. For those who didn't know already, the arrangements for the 200th changed yet again at the Christmas Hash, and there will now be a big celebration on **March 16th**. This will combine both the **200th** and the **10th anniversary** celebrations. It really genuinely is our 200th run - we don't piss about with run numbers unlike some other hashes!! Flyers have been sent to about 30 other hashes (And they really **are** good - the half-size monochrome reproduction in this organ really doesn't do it justice). Several old Quorn Hashers (i.e. Gentleman Jim, Good Moaning, Suterball... remember them?) will be mailed run sheets and flyers tomorrow. There will definitely be an RA (real ale) present at the event.

We will be taking over a sports club, with hot showers and changing facilities, and there is a full timetable of events (See inside). Details are still being finalised, but there will be some kind of piss-up the night before with crash space, Hash Games, some live entertainment, food and beer all for a paltry fiver. We need some idea of numbers by Run 199, so if you can't make the next few Hashes but would like to come to the 200th, please let us know.

Please come to the 200th - the event is being subsidised from the QH3 Coffers, and it would be a shame if we didn't spend our money on you. Also it would be a bit embarrassing if lots of visiting hashers turned up and very few of us were there.

Meanwhile all the intermediate runs will be worth coming to as well - for very different reasons. Run 197 will be Pleasure Gnome's 10th anniversary of hashing, which makes her slightly older than the Hash. Run 198, considering the date could be a Valentine's Day Hash, so let's hope the hare finds some love. The final piece of foreplay will be on March 2nd laid by more first-time hares. Run 182 was a joint run between us and the Mickleover H3. Relative pack sizes were: MH3 = 31, QH3 = 19.

"The stench is getting so bad that his neighbours have been seen retching as they pass by his house," a police spokesman told reporters in Xinying, South Taiwan. "But Chang Yuan-Ching still insists that the coroner was wrong, and that his wife will soon be coming back to life."

But he eventually promised us that, if his wife has not revived by the end of the year, then he'll agree to bury her. So you see, he's not completely unreasonable."

Go to jail, not home

A WOMAN jailed for five months for drink-driving walked out of a court when no-one turned up to take her to prison — and has now been charged with unlawful escape.

Anna Trevorrow, 29, was ordered to sit at the back of the courtroom in Penzance in Cornwall and wait for guards after she was sentenced.

But she was left alone when everyone left at the end of court business and walked out, so she decided to go home. She was later arrested.

Trevorrow, who has begun the original five-month sentence, now faces committal to crown court on the new charge.

Prosecuting solicitor Ron Ede told Penzance magistrates: "The Bench retired and went home. I went home, the defendant's solicitor went home and eventually the defendant went home as well. It seems there is no alternative but to charge her with unlawful escape. It's almost surreal but there we are."

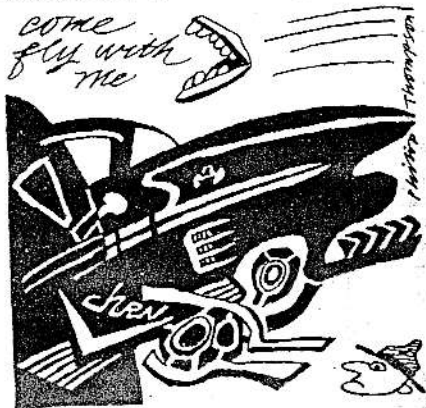

○ "Who can be absolutely sure? After all, there were no witnesses," a spokesman for the Arizona Highway Patrol told reporters. "But, after examining all the evidence, we're pretty certain this is what happened."

"Our patrol came across a pile of smouldering metal embedded in the side of a cliff in the desert. It looked like the impact of an aeroplane but we eventually realised it had once been a car, a Chevy Impala. It seems to us that the driver must have fitted his car with a Jet Assisted Take Off (JATO) unit, a solid fuel rocket intended for military planes, and decided to try it out on a straight, deserted highway, without realising the inevitable consequences. We think ignition



must have taken place 4.8km from the crash site, because there's a large area of melted asphalt there. The JATO would have reached maximum thrust within five seconds, producing a speed in excess of 800km/h. About fifteen seconds and four kilometres later, he must have applied the brakes, which immediately melted, blowing out the tyres and leaving thick rubber marks on the road surface. The car then became airborne and crashed into the cliff thirty-eight metres above the level of the road, leaving a blackened crater four metres deep. All that was left of the driver were his teeth, and even they'd melted. They were false teeth. The weird thing was that the radio was completely intact and still had power. When

we arrived it was tuned to our local radio station, and was playing 'Come Fly with Me'. I suppose that's what you call irony".

"This penis print scam is almost impossible to trace," Betty Nanywa told members of the Eastern Cape legislature as she presented the Health and Welfare Committee's report into fraud. The fence ended at a spot any normal hare would have put a check. Not our lads. We had flour on the paths to the left and right and, following a word from Oriface, we also found it straight on over a field of young crops. So why two false trails marked if no check? I asked Oriface who immediately blamed Lightning Rod - " He gets excited and a bit confused ".

We shortly came to the Star Inn at West Leake and the first check. Luckily the mornings weather was sunny and fairly warm ( stand-in R.A. Too Tuf doing an outstanding job controlling the weather ) otherwise we would have got cold waiting for the check to be solved. Come-on guys, think of your fellow Hashers, standing around on street corners, and put some effort into finding the trail. The hares were using the London bus style of trail laying, no checks for ages then two come along together. This one more speedily solved and the pack, together bar some walkers, set off on the fong, long, long ( we get the picture - Ed ) drag along farm lanes and fields to Kingston on Soar. Look that up on a map and you'll find its exactly bloody miles. Funnily enough the pack was more spread out now, best have a check.

We are like one big extended family, and the clubs are now spreading to France, Hong Kong, Italy and Japan. We are now seeking funds to establish a Laughter Research Centre in Korea."

9970. Crematoria Beware. Councils are calling for Government action to solve the problem of exploding heart pacemakers, which can detonate with the force of a hand grenade during the incineration of corpses, thereby damaging local crematoria. Doctors should be aware of the problems involved, and the next of kin should assume responsibility for ensuring that pacemakers are removed before cremation.

FIREFIGHTERS had to dismantle a whole bathroom after toddler Megan Parks got her finger stuck in the plughole of a bath. The firemen had to use cutting equipment to remove the bath from the wall to release the 15-month-old girl in Gosport, Hants.

### Beauty reform

HAITI is to hold its first true Miss Haiti beauty contest in several years, after allowing government officials to unilaterally choose the winner. Some 25 local belles are already preparing to don swimsuits and vie for the title on December 28. Promoter Rodney Daniel hopes the newly democratic contest will improve the country's image abroad. "There are a lot of beautiful, intelligent people here," he said.

"I thank God every hour that we weren't on that bridge when Thurston shot his nuts off, cos we'd both be pushing up the daisies by now," Billy Ray Wallis told reporters from his hospital bed in the Baptist Medical Center, Woodruff County. Poole (who sustained further abrasions from broken glass, and burns from fried onions) kept shouting at the diners to 'mind my frogs', while Wallis (who sustained a broken clavicle) attempted to steal a chip-fryer in the confusion. 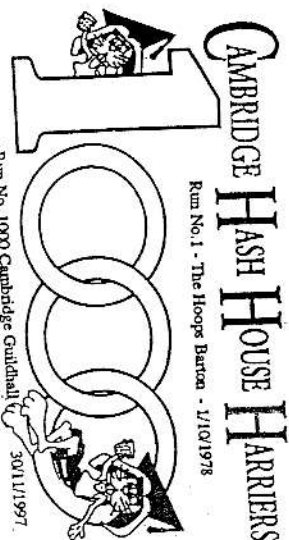

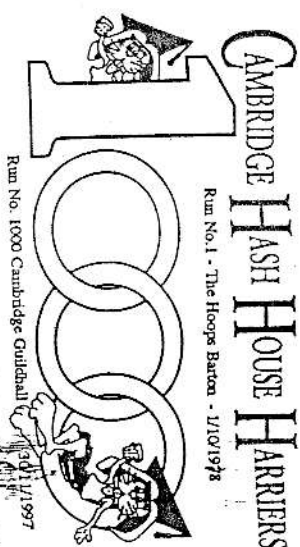

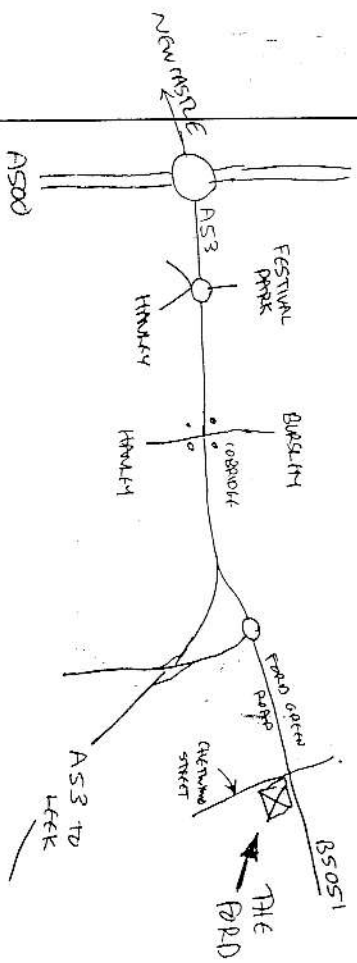

HASHING is a FUN SOCIAL jogging activity for the fit and not so fit. A trail of about four to five miles (with shortcuts always possible) is marked by ticks of flour by the "Hares". Trails normally follow a mixture of country footpaths, quiet roads and parklands. There are "Checks" marked at roughly 1/4 mile intervals from which there are several possible ways for the trail to go. Front runners explore the alternative ways until the real trail is identified, meanwhile the slower Hashers catch-up and/or rest. Fast & slower runners finish together. Hashing is not a race, the aim being for everyone to take as much exercise as they wish and for the slow and fast participants to be in close proximity throughout. Trails usually start and finish at a Pub, where it is customary for Hashers to linger awhile on their return, quench their thirst and offer the Hares their opinion of their skill in setting the trail. Non-serious running gear is normally worn, it may be muddy so it's best to bring a change of clothes. You are strongly advised to carry a robust torch for dark evenings.

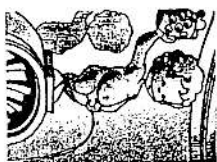

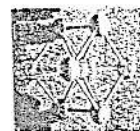

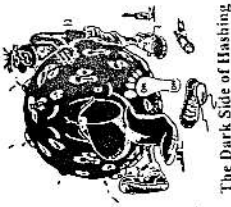
