

## Hash news

Happy new year to you all. The countdown to the 200th has begun. Several old Quorn Hashers (i.e. Gentleman Jim, Good Moaning, Suterball... remember them?) will be mailed run sheets and flyers tomorrow. There will definitely be an RA (real ale) present at the event.

We will be taking over a sports club, with hot showers and changing facilities, and there is a full timetable of events (See inside). Details are still being finalised, but therte will be some kind of piss-up the night before with crash space, Hash Games, some live entertainment, food and beer all for a paltry fiver. We need some idea of numbers by Run 199, so if you can't make the next few Hashes but would like to come to the 200th, please let us know.

Next Rash Hag: Run no. 199 (March 2nd).







O "Who can be absolutely sure? After all, there were no witnesses," a spokesman for the Arizona Highway Patrol told re-porters. "But, after examining all the evidence, we're pretty certain this is what

happened.
