





hat better way to explore Cyprus than to spend a quiet, sunny afternoon out

and about in the picturesque local countryside? And what better time than in early June, when the climate is somewhere near ideal?

A word of warning however: if you are planning such an excursion during the first weekend of June, you may find that some five thousand others have already had the same idea! Indeed you may find that your peaceful foray from the tourist areas becomes your first ever

encounter with a somewhat unorthodox, rather eccentric but dedicated group of sprinters, joggers and walkers.

This is not to suggest that the sizeable areas of forest, beach, plain and hinterland that make up this large island cannot accommodate that number. On the contrary, the Cyprus countryside could swallow up thousands more. But have in mind that this fun-running, funloving, multi-national group will be scaling mountains, traversing valleys and jogging through some of the most unlikely bundu and gullies in

O "I DON'T know what to say really," Police Captain Baird Davis told reporters in Muncie, near Indianapolis. They call themselves the Hash House Harriers, and they belong to a worldwide club, for want of a better word. Every two years members from all over the world assemble to partake in a three-day international gathering. This year, for the first time, Cyprus happens to be playing host. And with 'hashers' descending on the island from every part of the globe 'Interhash 96' will rank as one of the largest sporting events ever staged in Cyprus.

'Hashing', should you be unfamiliar with the phenomenon (as many are), has its roots steeped in tradition. In the 1870s a sporting group in London, known as the Thames Hare and Hounds, used to stage regular paperchases. Today's hashers follow much the same general pattern whereby a 'hare' lays a trail, using shredded paper or flour, for a group of runners known as the 'pack'. Their progress is likely to be a stop-start affair, for a cunning hare will lay a number of false trails, making good use of the local terrain to test the ingenuity of the pack.

Hashing historians widely recognise that a certain Albert Stephen Ignatius Gispert (known as 'G' to his friends), founded the modern day 'Hash House Harriers' in British colonial Kuala Lumpur in 1938. Well before the fitness era, and with none of today's sporting opportunities at their disposal, the group that formed in Malaysia ran for fun, as a means of occupying themselves in their spare time. The gatherings fostered camaraderie, and the enjoyment of the post-hash social get-together was as much a part of the concept as the running itself.

Over the years the idea of the hash has caught on in almost every country in the world. Cyprus, for example, has six 'kennels' or hashes and even a full-moon hash that runs once a month when the moon lights up the night sky. Groups run regularly in Limassol, Larnaca and Nicosia, while two of the island's hashes, in the British garrisons of Episkopi and Dhekelia, are the oldest surviving 'kennels' outside the Malaysian peninsula, having laid their first trails back in 1967.

Hashing is emphatically not about competing. Members move at exactly the pace that suits them. Some sprint, some run at an even, regular tempo, some jog and others bring up the rear of the pack at a stroll. Indeed athletic frames are in no great evidence among hashers, most of whom are everyday folk who love to unwind from a hectic week at the office with a

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

regular weekly run. But tricky terrain is par for the course, and hashers think nothing of scrambling across hillsides covered in dense bramble that tears and cuts into their shins as they search for the indistinct trail of shredded paper.

They're a jovial bunch and they tackle the important aftermath with equal gusto. At the mere mention of transgressing a trumped-up, unwritten rule during the run they'll oblige by paying the ultimate penalty: downing a tankard of ale in ten seconds.

Trevor Evans is one of Cyprus' hashing veterans who recalls running through "boulder strewn ravines and cliffs, and surviving scary hop-skip-and-jumps through snake-infested gullies. I got lost one hot summer's evening," he fondly

remembers, "and I ended up blundering through Erimi Village.
Through a blinding film of sweat I saw all heads in the coffee shop turn in disbelief towards me. Prominent among them with his chimney top hat, cassock and broad black beard was the portly village priest. As I shambled by he crossed himself and exclaimed to his flock, "This sight is a bad omen ... Drink my children to turn away the Evil Eye!"

The official hosts of Interhash

"96 are the Amathus Hash House Harriers (AH3) in Limassol. John Jackson, the Interhash chairman, explains why Cyprus lends itself so well to the occasion: "Ideal hashing countryside, wonderful food and, most importantly, excellent beer - it's the perfect venue for the Interhash.

"We have been described as 'a drinking club with a running

problem'," he beams, "and this is because we place as much emphasis on the post-hash socialising as we do on the run itself."

The organisers, all volunteers,

are expecting up to 5,000 hashers to wing their way to the island from 60 countries, with Cyprus Airways acting as a major sponsor for the event. And the Interhash is certainly going to introduce Cyprus to faces from some far flung points of the globe. Besides many European and middle eastern entries there are registrations from as far afield as Papua New Guinea, Swaziland, Trinidad and Vietnam; from Iceland, China, Honduras and Vanuatu (a group of islands in the Pacific) ...

What exactly does the Interhash involve? For the running itself the hashers are to be divided into ten runs that will take place at different run-sites, all of them within an hour's drive of Limassol. These are organised for Saturday and Sunday, June 8th and 9th. Then there are three evenings of festivities, including

June 7th, which will be staged at the municipal gardens in Limassol. Hashers will be feted with local culinary delights, endless supplies of beer (not surprisingly one of the island's major breweries is a cosponsor) and entertainment including music and sideshows. Some of the visitors will be arriving with partners and families and many are expected to stay on the island for a fortnight. Hash house 'hariettes' and even a few 'pups' are likely to number among them on the runs.

How will Cyprus fare from this fun-running invasion? The reaction of the Interhash '94 host country, New Zealand, puts the experience into perspective. The General Manager of Rotorua tourism recalls effusively that it was a privilege to host the event. "Culturally Rotorua residents were treated to an enjoyable week of open and warm camaraderie on a scale not often seen. Come back anytime!"
