
HASH NEWS

BERKSHIRE 900th - Barn Elms Farm, Bradfield

This is the full story about how 8 of us set off to do the Berkshire 900th. Only 2 of us actually did the run, and three didn't even find the venue! More about that later.


It was a crisp sunny day when three intrepid Hashers (Barritone, Grope=Her and Moby dick) set off from Nottingham. At Barrow-Upon-Soar we met up with four more reprobates (Mango, Cyranose, Josh and Rockhopper), who were already rather sozzled with wine. At this point there were two questions on everybody's lips: How on earth did Josh get that black eye? and Who will get so pissed on Saturday night they get lost?

We went in convoy, which went as smooth as a condor up to the M40 Interchange at Brackley, where Josh pulled into the services for a pee. However, we were soon back on the road, back down to the county where your scribe spent his mis-spent youth!!

At this point, I alighted at Pangbourne where my crash space was. I don't remember much about the evening, except that I left the pub at about 12:15 (Mind you, it does help to have your brother serving behind the bar). everybody else rolled up at cycological's hash hovel, where they had a whale of a time! Josh and Cyranose decided to go on a 4-hour romantic walk in the rain instead of returning home. At this point Rockhopper, sensible soul that he is, assumed that Josh and Cyranose were lost (Correct), and that therefore they would go to the police station to ask the local bobby the way (Wrong). The rather bemused policeman, however, assumed Rockhopper was a drunk (Correct), and promptly arrested him. Meanwhile... "Gosh, I feel hungry!", gasped Moby Dick and promptly devoured a whole bowl of raw onions!

The next morning I found myself in the amazing position of being only 3 miles from a Hash Venue!! Three bleary-eyed Hashers stumbled out from Pangbourne: Barritone, Barritone's brother Colin, and Rachel - a virgin!! among the usual Berkshire crowd was a plethora of familiar faces: Wha de Say and Fag End from Bicester, Doggy Bag (on her way from Milton Keynes back down to Brighton), and Doc Crippen, who had wisely made his own way down (Rachel was very impressed by his jeep!) The hares, Grey Elf and Morribaby, were instantly recognisable by some amazing 3 foot antlers, plus balloons attached to various parts of their anatomy. Cycological said he didn't think the other Quorn Hashers had arrived, though he wasn't sure why.

The horn blew and we were off! Rachel took the Mini, the rest of us plumped for the Main. The first cunning plan unfolded: no flour for the first 400 metres, but still we followed each other like sheep. Barritone gingerly checked past a pond and alongside the river bank. It was then that you knew you were on a typical Berkshire Hash: up to your waist in the freezing, appropriately named river Pang!! Some athletic wimps ran an extra mile to find a bridge over troubled water. The rest of us scrambled through the undergrowth on this Jungle Run, eventually coming out at the river bank.

At the next check there was no way to go except straight on or across the river; Wha De Say and some other Bicester Hashers enthusiastically waded across, but this time it was a double bluff, and the trail continued straight on. Barritone ran up a long uphill false trail before the real trail emerged in Bradfield village. "Gosh, there is a lot of shiggy, isn't there!", quoth Crippen, more used to running on asphalt these days.

The trail continued through the village and into the school grounds - much to the delight of Colin, who was a former pupil there and was planning on showing his girlfriend round. "This is the assault course", he enthused. Indeed, that is where the trail went, over a narrow log straddling the muddy Pang. Doc Crippen was very disappointed the trail didn't include the rest of the Assault Course, continuing instead along the bank to the rugby pitches. This was a good check, the trail eventually back-tracking past the Headmaster's house, up a hill to the start of the "cheese". This, to the uninitiated, is a cross-country course, so called because of the smell emanating from your feet afterwards. That is precisely what we followed for the next 45 minutes. Indeed Colin said at every check, "If the hare were following the Bradfield Cheese, he would have gone this way...", and he was right, every time! We went up a hill, through a tunnel until eventually, near Jacob's Ladder, the trail went the "wrong" way. Doc Crippen was now behind us, but he soon caught us up, and we descended into a sleepy little village with a green and a little bench. "That deserves a down down!" yelled a Berkshire Hasher to Colin, taking a well earned rest. He was up like a shot!

The next downhill stretch was so shiggified that it was impossible to run down; indeed the only practical method of descent was to bend your knees and adopt a ski position. It was then that the reason for our "deviation" was discovered - we were now on another "cheese", and local knowledge reasserted itself. "this is the water jump!", enthused Colin. The hare, wasn't being that cruel though, and with clockwork precision we re-joined the Mini for a cider stop by the road. After the wet T-shirt competition Daz (Complete with sponsorship) and Grey Elf (Still wearing those antlers) announced that the trail would split into 3: an ultra long run for Finch, a midi and a mini. Barritone decided after much dithering to do the midi, and took the high road through some pine forest.

What an amazing sight as 150 heaving sweaty bodies poured into the barn: no less than six cauldrons of various curries and chillies with ladies stirring them (Boil and bubble, toil and trouble, etc.) I was assured I could have everything (Food that is!) and so piles and piles of delicious animal protein entered tired, wet bodies. There were also huge hunks of bread and a bar serving Wadworth's 6X at a very reasonable £1.40 per pint! After the usual down-downs (Hares, new shoes, etc.) a representative from each Hash was asked to find a partner of the opposite sex. Your scribe, not being blessed (or cursed?!) with the distaff side, disposed of his down-down in the conventional manner. Afterwards the farmer was awarded a down down for the use of his barn. THE HOMECOMING DIAMOND CELEBRATION

The sport of Hashing will be 60 years old in 1998, and the combined Kuala Lumpur and Klang Valley Hash Chapters are bidding to hold INTERHASH 1998 back where it all began, on the trails and terraces of the rubber and oil palm estates, and in the secondary jungles of Kuala Lumpur and the Klang Valley - and not forgetting the surrounding hills! It is thus the Diamond Jubilee of the whole Hash movement and we'll be asking the Hash World to come back for The Homecoming Diamond Celebration in the best possible way, by allowing us to bring INTERHASH 1998 back to its roots, in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia.

Malaysia has some of the finest Hashing country in the world, and it is no coincidence that the sport started and flourished here. We now have over 100 chapters in Malaysia alone, with 14 of them in Kuala Lumpur and the Klang Valley. Though there are, by our estimates, over 1,250 active Hash chapters worldwide, with a total Hashing community of about 100,000, Malaysia must still be one of the most Hashed countries in the world, on either a per capita or a square kilometre basis, and it's no wonder, with nearly 75% of the country still covered by natural rain forest, rubber plantations, oil palm or tea estates - it's just natural Hash country.

A typical run within 40 kms of Kuala Lumpur, could start in a flattish area of oil palm, move quickly into steeply terraced rubber, take in a hilltop (or two) of secondary rain forest, descend through a valley of dense jungle, drop into a refreshing waterfall, and finish down an ambling stream with overhanging drooping bamboo plants dipping into the water - absolutely fabulous! Every Hasher in the world really should come back to the spiritual home of Hashing at least once in their lifetime, just to sense the forces that created their sport.

With so many Hash chapters to choose from, you could spend a happy fortnight Hashing from one end of Peninsular Malaysia to the other (plus a fair few on the East Malaysian, or Borneo side), and that is one of the packages we'll be offering you in '98. And as if that weren't enough, we'll have some 50 total holiday package options for you, which in addition to the events of INTERHASH 1998, could include:-

- Scuba Diving in remote Sipadan, one of the world's finest dive sites; Climbing Mount Kinabalu in Sabah (14,000 ft !); Rain Forest Trekking in our National Park 'Taman Negara'; Exploring the fantastic Mulu Caves or climbing the extraordinary Pinnacles in Sarawak; Visiting the Danum Valley Rain Forest Research Centre in Sabah; Touring down the rivers in Sarawak and visiting Iban Longhouses; Visiting the Historic Sites of the old Straits Settlements, Penang, Malacca and Singapore; Lying on the fabulous beaches of Langkawi or Tioman Islands, etc., etc., etc., but we'll be telling you much more about these other aspects of Malaysia in subsequent 'flyers'.

1 VISAS

Do I need a visa to get into Cyprus? Basically - YES. **How do I get one?** Unless you are a Turk or Iraqi, you can GET ONE AT THE AIRPORT ON ARRIVAL. Anyone except the poor unfortunate nationals of Turkey and Iraq either don't need one at all i.e. poms, frogs, cloggies, seppies, etc. or can get a tourist visa on arrival. This is valid for a month. The minimum stay is a week, and you must have the usual onward or return ticket and funds for your stay. Turks and Iraqis MUST apply in advance through a Cypriot consular office or through the British Embassy, who issue visas on Cyprus' behalf. This looks pretty bleak for Iraqi hashers but there you go. Life really IS a bitch sometimes.

2 SO YOU WANT TO BRING YOUR KIDS

There's always at least one poor demented loon who insists on bringing his family to Interhash - a bit like taking your wife to Bangkok, really. Be that as it may, as the first Family Hash to host Interhash, we are laying on a walk for the more sedentary hashers. The price for pups is, under 6's, FREE, and from 6 - 16, \$30, which gets them food and softies, plus buses and runs/walks but no goodie bag. Lest anyone think we are REALLY stupid - although we must be pretty dim to offer to host this jamboree in the first place - Under 6 means "born on or after 7th June 1990", and Under 16, on or after 7th June 1980.

3 HOTELS AND ACCOMMODATION

Included with this tome is a list of hotels in Limassol. This is to give you an idea of the choice available. If you want to book now, go ahead, but hotel deals will become available in August 95. Cypriana Holidays are opening their hotel offers to all Interhashers, together with a transfer service from Larnaca or Paphos airports. Details of this and how to book, will be coming out in the next flier, scheduled for Summer 95. When we DO get the fliers out next summer - BOOK EARLY! If people don't book early, the tour operators will have to release their room allocations. The best deal WILL BE the Cypriana Holidays offer.

4 FLIGHTS AND TRAVEL

The flight's dilemma - do I book it now or later - dead easy! You can't book now, as neither scheduled or charter flights are open yet. Cyprus Airways will open their flights for this period in November '95. They are going to set up a special ticketing unit in the Limassol Cyprus Airways office, just for us. Address and contact details in the next flier, hopefully. Also in the next flier will be a flight request form. You don't send it to us - you send it to them!

Cyprus Airways will give any registered hasher a discounted flight price, using their network of partner airlines. These include Emirates and United Airlines. They can do this 'cos they will be selling you the ticket. In case you are thinking - what about all those people - all going to Cyprus at once - have no fear, Cyprus Airways have confirmed that they will uplift all passengers on their network, which is going to mean extra flights to Dubai, for sure. Also included with this flier is a separate flier on travel.

5 WHAT ELSE IS GOING ON

At the time of going to press, pre-hash rambles are scheduled in Dubai (courtesy of the Desert, Creek and Falcon H3s, contact Bollockwacker, Ian Binnie on Fax 971-8469334, or PO Box 3627, Dubai, UAE) and possibly Singapore and in the London Area. Immediately after Interhash, the Lustboat sets sail for a trip over to Egypt. The MV Romantica, owned by Paradise Cruises, will depart on a day yet to be fixed from Limassol to Port Said. There you get up nice and early, jump on a bus to Cairo, have a look at King Tut in the museum, stagger up the inside of the great Pyramid, stagger back down, and - meet Cairo H3 to hash in the Giza area, followed by food and what, for want of a better word we will call beer, before falling back onto the buses and returning to Port Said and Limassol. Indicative prices are between \$100 and \$200 a person, depending on how far below the waterline your cabin is. Check with a travel agent if you need a visa for Egypt.

6 HARRIETTES AND OTHER MINORITY INTERESTS

A little bird whispered in my ear in Rotorua (actually bitched away like shit for about 10 minutes) that no specific welcome was given to the Harriettes. Just in case we forget in the future, Welcome - Harriettes! Seriously, folks - well, not too seriously, actually, as the first family hash to host Interhash we are extending a real welcome to all MOOS*, pups, hash widows, etc. Equally, we are not forgetting Vegetables.

7 JOSE CUERVO

Bushwacker has been talking to us - for those that weren't there, Bushwacker is the Jose Cuervo Tequila man. Basically, we have told him, "it ain't broke, don't fix it," and we are HOPING to repeat the Rotorua experience. Watch this space.

8 REGISTERING





