Back to the pub where Dobber joined Too Tuf from QH3 to perform the necessary down-downs to - Phil Mead - no prize for winning

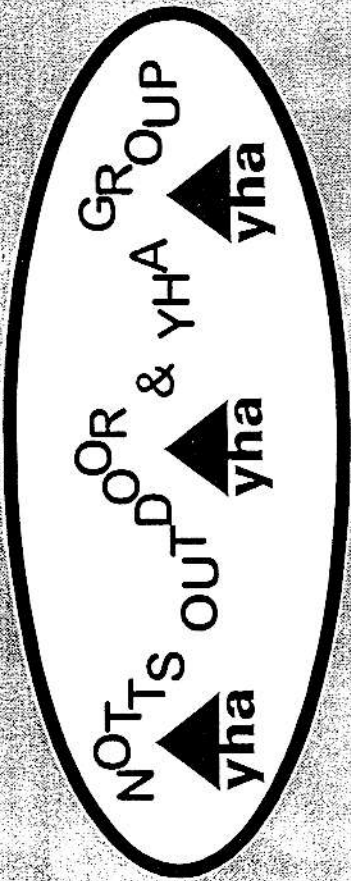

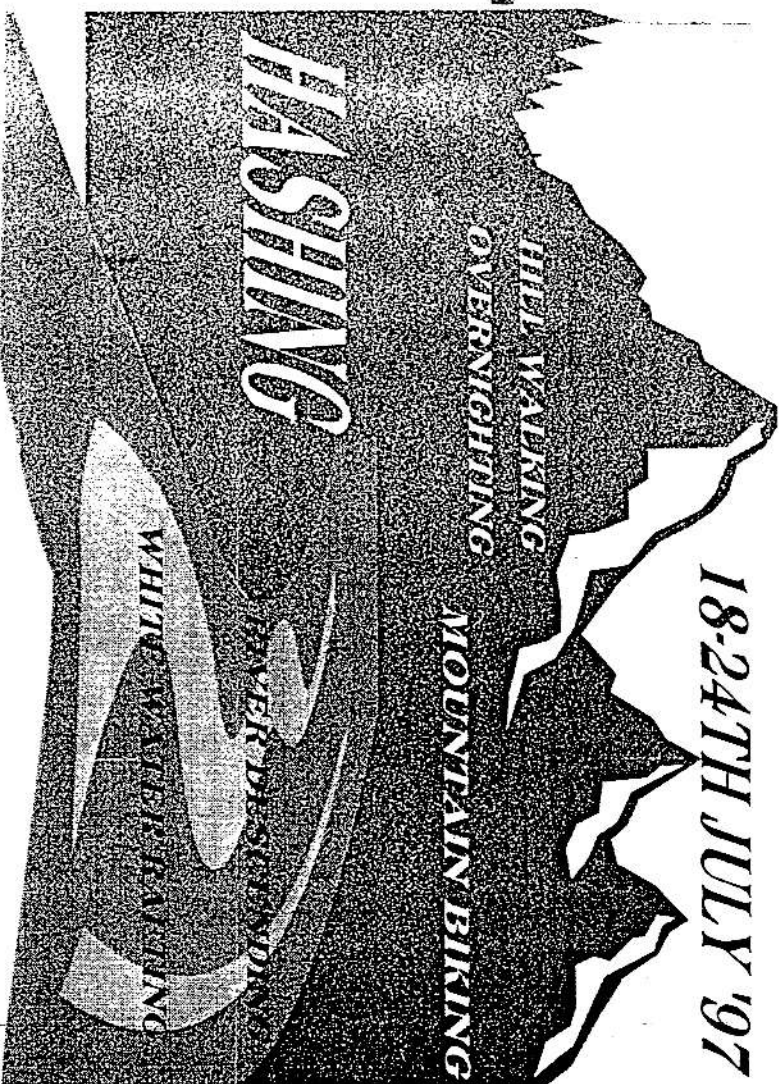

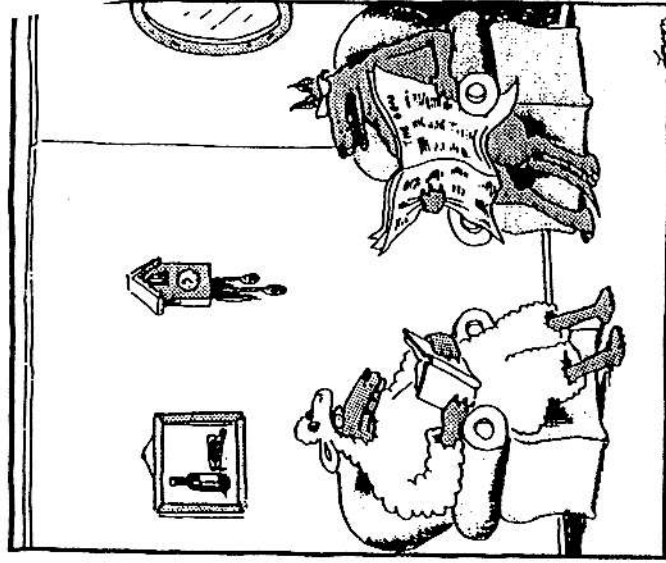

This event attracted a huge turnout - 10, I believe. It took us quite a while to find the venue - an outdoor education centre for children with special educational needs (It transpired that someone had nicked the sign) However - never mind - after a quick erection in the rain it was straight down the pub, where a large number of Hashers from all round the country were already gathered. Despite the fact that it hardly ever let off raining all weekend it was summer after all - and we soon got into the spirit of Summer when we grappled with Josh's Gazebo, with some welcome help from the Churn Valley Hash (What a nice bunch of people they were). The bar wasn't meant to open, but that didn't stop Wimpey climbing in through the window, where everybody else then resolved to keep the bar open all night.

A hearty breakfast with lost of black pudding (which Lucy enjoyed more than everybody else), and it was back out to the rain. We were bussed out to the run site - a good hour away on the coast (why they had to go so far when there was so much beautiful countryside on our doorstep was anybody's guess). Anyway, it was an excellent trail, which started off going *up* a river, and led us through woods and fields. It stopped raining just as Yours Truly entered a clearing on a hill, which afforded some wonderful seaside views. I think I could see Merseyside, though I couldn't be sure. There was a good circle before going back to the site, where the beer was now in full flow - and free! However, they soon livened up and got everybody moving with a few Irish jigs, and old faves like Wild Rover. The highlight of the disco had to be Hey Macarena - which Halfpint and Brerphil were leading. Back to the bar, when everybody resolved again to keep it open all night. Halfpint wanted to go to bed, but his wife Brerphil was more keen to let it all hang out, in more ways than one. "My, what big tits you have!", exclaimed Too Tuf, wide eyed with admiration.

The next day's hash was from the site, and what a wonderful run it was too - it had a bit of everything - more rivers, caves, rocks, woodland, fields, even a huge intimidating Beware of the Dog sign (it turned out to be a poodle about the size of a domestic cat!!)
