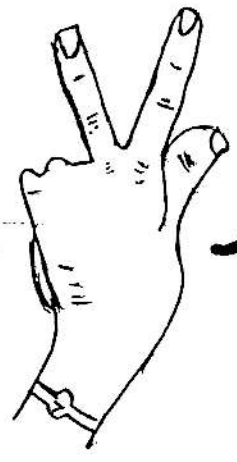

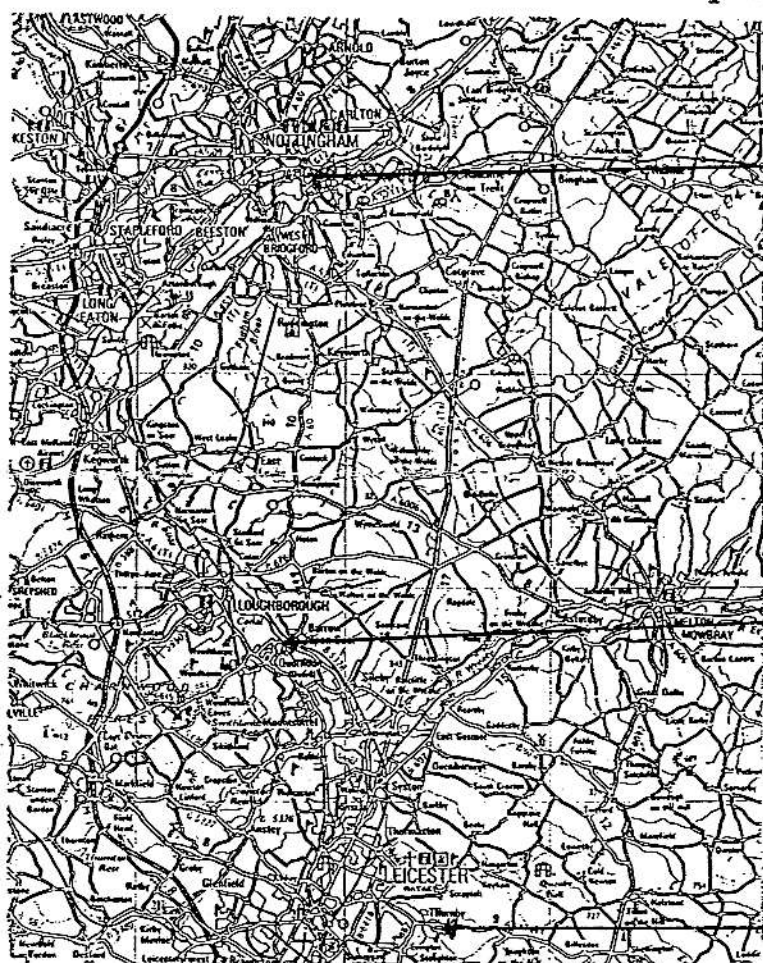

HASH NEWS

- 1) Welcome to a somewhat thinner edition of Rash Hag. Inside find a full report on Nash Hash, among other things.
- 2) It is my happy duty to inform you that Eurohash '95 ON ON in September, despite rumours to the contrary. As well Eurohash '95 it will also be the Zagreb 1000th celebration. You've heard all the jokes - it'll certainly give a new meaning to the phrases "This beach is all mine", or "Let's get legless tonight". Seriously though, the Foreign Office says that the Dalmation Islands (of which Hvar is one), and Istria are SAFE, and there are still plenty of tourists there. Vienna H3 are supporting the event, and wish to inform everybody that it's on. It's miles and miles away from any fighting. Further information is given below.
- 3) Manneke Pis are bidding to host Eurohash '97 in Brussels. The vote will be decided in Hvar.
- 4) Anyone who went to Teign Valley's excellent 500th weekend last October will be pleased to know that they are hosting Nash Hash '97. They won the vote by a huge margin at Nash Hash. The other contenders were Wirral and Chester H3, who wanted to host it in the sports complex where Chariot Of Fire was filmed, with national TV coverage, and Bicester H3, who made their bid on a "Back to Basics" ticket on a farm. Teign Valley already have three possible venues lined up, and support from FOUR brewers, and have really got their act together. They promise a mini beer festiva where all the beer is free.
- 5) Meanwhile, as reported in May's Rash Hag, KLH3 (The Mother Hash) are bidding for Interhash '98, and are promoting it in a big way. The only other contender at present is Cairns H3 (in Oz). I have lots of promotional material on this. They intend to hold it at the beginning of October, in the week after the Commonwealth Games in Malaysia.
- 6) Hobart H3, together with other Tasmanian chapters, are bidding for Interhash 2000. Rivals are Queensland. The Ozzie event should coincide nicely with the Olympics in Sydney.
- 7) Meanwhile, closer to home, the annual Firework Run will take place from the Navigation, Barrow Upon Soar on SATURDAY November 4th at 6 p.m. Please note the time! The run will be followed by bonfire and fireworks at the pub (6 real ales!), and crash space in various Hash Hovels in the village. Please bring torches. There may be a Hangover Hash the followin morning.
- 8) The backlog of write-ups is creeping up again. Hares are still needed for November and December, so if you haven't laid a trail for some time (or indeed haven't laid a trail at all!), now's your big chance to be a deviou bastard!

Four of us sped down the M1 in the Hashmobile to Nash Hash '95: Too Tuf, Pleasure Gnome, Barritone and Mango. We pitched up next to the Milton Keynes and East Lancs lot, and then wandered round to see who we could see. Same old faces? Well... almost. Tommy Two Lips has had a drastic haircut ... So has Saddlesniffer... Halfpint was seriously hirsute... Robo had gone for the Mafia Moustache... We had a quick erection in the field, then headed for the pub, where we met up with Doc Crippen and Suterball. The pub were warned about us and told to get some extra beer, but by the following morning the pub had been drained dry! Meanwhile Magic was soaking up the atmosphere, grinning like a cheshire cat.

After closing time, Posi announced that the Nash Hash Bar was open, and free!! There then followed an 800m sprint to the Beer Tent, where more souls were gathering. At the stroke of midnight the event officially opened with trumpets and expansive film soundtrack, before giving way to the story of Farmer Boyson's Cow. The story is, briefly, this: Four years ago there was a hash through a field of cows. Along comes Farmer Boyson, shouting "Get off my fucking land!" and similar profanities. The next morning, a cow dies. There was then a healthy exchange of letters between the Hash and the National Farmers Union, who were attempting to sue the Hash for the death of the cow. The next morning, the hearty 4-course breakfast did wonders to soak up the alcohol in the veins, as the ladies of the canteen did a sterling job rushing back and forth with endless pots of tea. Then it was On On for the buses, each run being set by a different Hash. Your scribe plumped for "9 1/2 weeks" set by Berkshire H3, and for some strange reason only 12 others followed suit. Nonetheless Great Elk laid an absolutely superb trail, through beautiful rolling downland and woodland, ending up at a pub with a self-service Ploughman's lunch and some gorgeous juicy apples (shhhh! - don't tell the landlady!) Mango and Suterball, gluttons for punishment, opted for the Surrey Mega-run (Where they received down-downs for wearing bum-bags), while Pleasure-gnome and Too Tuf went for the Hursley and Worthy run with thai food at the end. We got back at tea-time (or rather beer-time), where even more people were gathering - including Torch Killer as Glenn Close, and a large contingent from Manneke Pis H3.

CUT!!!

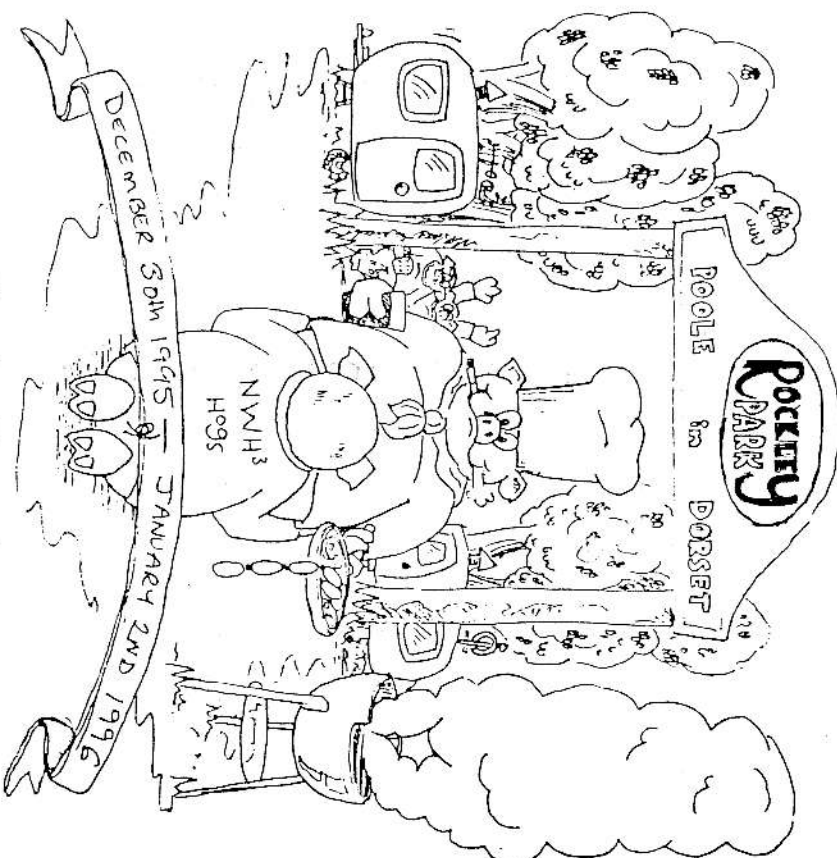

Shakedown in Dubai
