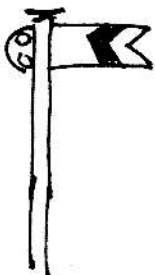

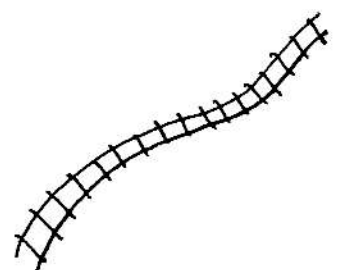
RUN 51 : The Scalford, Melton Mowbray

28 April 1991

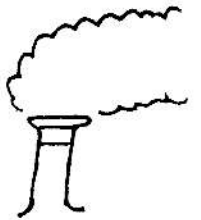
The trail meandered on, over bridges, under bridges to our destination.
